

EMPLOYEE FREE CHOICE ACT BEFORE SENATE

The Employee Free Choice Act, which passed the House of Representatives last month, is currently being considered by the US Senate.

The measure would make it easier and safer for employees to unionize by authorizing card check recognition, strengthening the protections for workers doing union organizing, and strengthening the provision for negotiating first time contracts.

Union members and supporters are urged to email or write Senator Barbara Boxer and Dianne Feinstein expressing their support for the measure. Both Senators are co-sponsors of the current bill.
